PROPOSAL FOR EMPLOYEE AWARD, AUCTIONING AGENCY, WHISTLE BLOWERS AND FINING MPs



Given the degree of moral decay, debt burden, employ absenteeism and tax evasion/defaulting challenging Uganda this is to propose that

1. Finance ministry create a Public-Private Auctioning Agency (PPAA) which sales all spoilt/old government machines, devices, vehicles, equipment and gadgets to voters and then use the accrued funds to supplement the servicing of the national debt because government organizations are littered with spoilt machineries, devices, vehicles and equipment countrywide which can fetch billions of shillings if well auctions.
2. Auditor General (AG), Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) and Inspector general of government (IGG) work with the Bankers Association to collectively award employees who have worked with an organization/company for years without a dent of corruption. And also ensure that anyone who has a national I.D card has a TIN number connected to their phone number(s) so as to disconnect them automatically from communicating before clearing their income tax.

3. Parliament, enact a law which fines MPs one million shillings (UGX-1m) or so for each day they fail to attend parliament sittings without substantial prior notice to parliament.

The trading of evidence will motivate the friends, workers or relatives etc. who are within the circles of the culprit to surrender such evidence for monetary gains which they cannot get from the culprit. While the youths should not spend their hard-earned commission on liabilities like a leisure car etc. for public opinion before setting up a formal income generating asset on purpose for living because financial literacy plus financial intelligence over financial discipline leads to financial independence.
