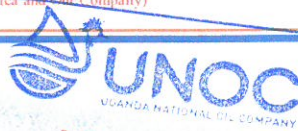

## INCENTIVIZING ENGINEERING, SUPPLY, EXPLORATION AND INNOVATION


To gradually articulate **Vision 2040** through incentives for sustainable development and collective prosperity, this is to propose that,
