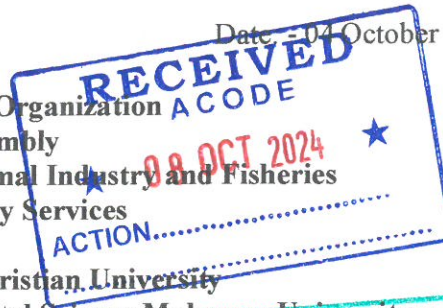

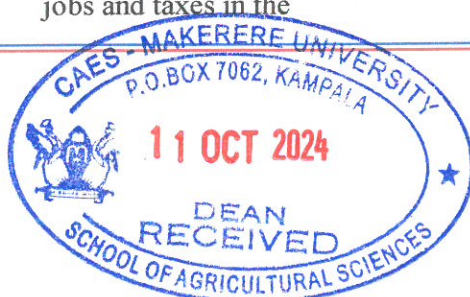

While farmers who have with goats, cattle, sheep etc. use fruit trees to partition, shade and fencing your farms so as to mitigate the effects of climate change while producing surplus fruits. However, the NFIA should gradually sell forty percent (40%) shares to the public through an IPO so as to spread the risks.
